COLUMBARIUM

Definition:

A chamber or wall in which urns containing the cremated remains of the dead are stored.

Urn

Definition:

A vase in which the cremated remains of somebody who has died and been cremated are kept.

Niche

Definition:

A Niche is a recess in which an urn containing cremated remains is placed in a columbarium.

Each niche is 12" square and will allow for one (1) or (2) interments depending on the size of the container used.

The use of wood, cardboard or any other biodegradable substance will not be allowed. Ceramic, glass, bronze, marble or plastic urns are required.

<u>Interment</u>

A Cremation Certificate is required before interment can take place.

A Cemetery attendant is required for the interment in the Columbarium. A fee is required as outlined in the Columbarium Fee Schedule.

Inscriptions

Inscriptions are to be bought through the Cemetery to ensure that they remain uniform. See Columbarium Fee Schedule for prices.

The inscription will be arranged by the Cemetery attendant. A fee is required and outlined in the Columbarium Fee Schedule.

Benches

Benches may be sponsored by individuals or groups and must be purchased through the Cemetery Company.

Flowers or Decorations

No flowers or decorations will be allowed on the Columbarium or surrounding area.
